# Principal's Report

#### • Mrs. McMullen

- Go Guardian real time online tech info and data software purchased for \$8K using Title 1 monies, Central Cambria paid for professional development (\$3,500). Training for teachers begins Oct. 13<sup>th</sup>.
- o New Holy Name School Handbooks completed and will be sent out on Friday.
- October 14th clearance audit for the entire diocese. Two schools hosting auditing team.
  Updated clearance documentation needed for school and rectory.
- Halloween teachers do not need volunteers for classrooms. Mrs. McMullen wants 6-8 volunteers to help with BINGO for grades 4th and up, which will called from the office.
  Teachers will be given pre-arranged bags and prizes, would like volunteers to pass out prizes (Friday 1 to 2:30pm). Also need volunteers to pass out pumpkins (PreK to 8th grade).
- Nov 10th Next Gen meeting will include a 5th grade performance play, chairs will be 3 feet apart, masks expected.
- December primary grades turn to do Christmas play. Will prepare 10 songs, with every 3rd song including a small play. Will be held in the church. Any student participating must have a Covid form signed, and permission slip that they can participate (no dates set yet).
